A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY TAX COLLECTION COMMITTEE, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING AND EMPOWERING ITS LOCAL TAX COLLECTOR, BERKHEIMER, TO IMPOSE, RECOVER AND RETAIN COSTS OF COLLECTION ON DELINQUENT TAXES.

WHEREAS, the Local Tax Enabling Act ("LTEA"), authorizes certain political subdivisions to levy, assess and collect a tax on salaries, wages, commissions, compensation and earned income of individuals, as therein with more particularity specified, generally and hereinafter referred to as the "Earned Income Tax"; and

**WHEREAS,** the LTEA establishes Tax Collection Districtions ("TCD") comprised of political subdivisions located within the geographic boundaries of the TCD, or as otherwise provided, that have imposed and levied the earned income tax, governed by a Tax Collection Committee ("TCC"); and

WHEREAS, the NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY TAX COLLECTION COMMITTEE, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, has hired Berkheimer to collect said taxes levied by the municipalities and school districts ("Taxing Authorities") located within the Northumberland County Tax Collection District, including taxes that are or may become delinquent; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Act 192 of the 2003-2004 General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Taxing Authorities located within the Northumberland County TCD, have the right to impose a cost of collection on taxes that become delinquent and/or that remain due and unpaid;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that

- 1. **NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY TAX COLLECTION COMMITTEE, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY,** APPROVES AND ADOPTS the Cost of Collection Schedule attached hereto and made apart of this Resolution to be imposed, recovered and retained by BERKHEIMER upon any taxpayer whose taxes are or become delinquent and/or remain due and unpaid.
- 2. **BERKHEIMER** is authorized to impose, recover and retain said costs of collection set forth in the attached schedule incurred in recovering delinquent taxes and assessed to the delinquent taxpayer as allowed by law.
- 3. Any resolution or part of this resolution conflicting with the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
